CALL TO ORDER

NEW BUSINESS

Heinzman not in attendance to discuss written guidelines for NCRA regarding assisting in recreation projects.

Badgero stated that Mark Pitzer of the Pickle Ball organization asked if their organization could fill in the cracks on the courts and are willing to pay for it. They will contact the company that NCRA used to reseal/resurface the courts to match up the material/color. Smith will do up a waiver for that group to sign and Smith also needs to know the date they plan on filling in the cracks. Badgero will get that information to him.

BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Smith stated that the United Way will be voting today as to whether to cover the additional costs Prevention of Child Abuse needs to put up the pavilion in Henning Park; he believes it will be a go. Newaygo County Parks will be putting \$5,000 towards the project for parking and picnic tables and NCRA will be donating \$1,000 once they receive an invoice.
