KEY ACTIVITIES

Muskegon River Bluffs Disc Golf Course: 50% of \$175 raised. Two fairway trails completed. Plans and costs of forestry work in process through NC Parks. Possible Phase One 9-hole course.

MEDC RRC Project: City rebranding underway with Third Coast Creative. Final visual concepts to present to City Council March 8.

Christian Healthcare Centers: Railside property purchase agreement signed. Project Scope finalized as expanded single story building, to include CHC Primary Care and Christian Healthcare Specialists.

LMI and Workforce housing projects: Sites include Sand Mold, Industrial Park lots, OZ properties. Investigating Charitable Land Trust. UCC site (18 units) developing. Visser River Run apartments leasing now, Phase 2 Begun.

Sable Homes' River Hills phase two passed by Brownfield Board, County Board of Commissioners, Infrastructure construction underway. More new homes to start in 2021.

Newaygo Crossing: MSUCEA Economic Impact Analysis final report received. EGLE Permit approved thru 7/8/2025. Ravine bridge soil boring & engineering complete. Easement from NC Parks and grant sought from FACF both denied.

Museum Project awarded to Copper Rock Construction. Project will begin Spring 2021. Museum to be temporarily relocated to Leppinks plaza. Project needs additional \$300K funding.

I Am Newaygo! Public Engagement Forum being re-evaluated. Potential of integrating under City of Newaygo existing social media platforms and website.

Social Zone- working with River Country Chamber of Commerce on Social Zone project in raised area behind RS Cafe, Sportsmans Bar, and RS Saloon and alleyways.
