NEW BUSINESS

Schneider explained to the Board that a Housing Task Force sub-committee was formed from NEDO. Their main focus has been issues related to the need for additional housing. Schneider and Board went over document of recommendations that the Housing Task Force had put together.

Schneider and the Board discussed the Master Plan suggestions from the Consultants. They discussed pervious pavement, additional ways to highlight the river and the need for public restrooms in the downtown area.

Schneider stated that the City Council had approved striping for additional parking for the block around City Hall with moving the curb and sidewalk in about five feet along Quarterline. Schneider stated that they are discussing options with MDOT regarding M-37. He said a group is working on the Rustic Trail Way, which runs along the river East of M37 and extends the Riverfront Trail.

Schneider stated that there was a NEDO update in their packet. He updated Board on MEDC Façade Grant and showed a Magna Site Plan stating that Magna had purchased the additional parcel (Harris property) along Division Street.
